

1957 Harley-Davidson ST165

The lightweight two stroke Harleys were produced from 1948 to 1966.

The design was a copy of the DKW RT125, acquired at the end of World War II from the occupied German plant.

With the introduction of these lightweights it was hoped that they would bring younger buyers into a Harley dealership, hopefully moving up to one of the full size models at a late date.

The ST 165 was priced at a reasonable \$445.00.
