

**PETIT LE MANS CONFIRMED TO HOST ACO'S  
INTERCONTINENTAL LE MANS CUP IN 2011**

The Automobile Club de l'Ouest (ACO) today confirmed that Petit Le Mans at Road Atlanta will be featured as part of the prestigious Intercontinental Le Mans Cup (ILMC) championship next season.

Monday's announcement completed the full 2011 schedule which includes the two races in the American Le Mans Series, the European-based Le Mans Series and the Asian Le Mans Series - as well as Le Mans itself as a double-points event. Petit Le Mans (October 1, 2011) will be the sixth race of the seven event global championship format.

"We are thrilled to announce that all the details have been finalized and the Intercontinental Le Mans Cup, one of the premier motorsport competitions in the world, will include Petit Le Mans for the second straight year as originally planned" said Geoff Lee, President of Road Atlanta. "The 2010 race was a huge success which saw record attendance and unprecedented drama on the track.
