



The 19th Annual ICEBOWL

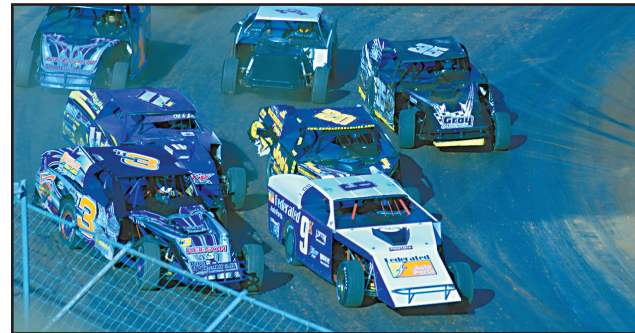
