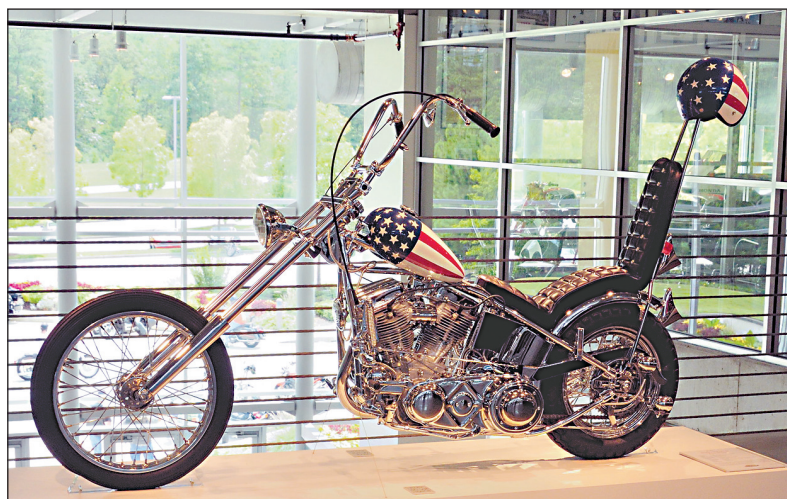

If you ever considered racing your utv, dirt bike, or atv check out Broad River Adventure Park race series, a race series that is designed for the weekend warriors. The bike/atv race course consist of 1 mile of motocross and around 4 miles of woods. Nothing to technical for the beginner but still challenging at a pro level. The utv's have a separate race course to accommodate the bigger machines.

The race classes consist from pro to beginners, men, women, and youth. Awards given at each race with a points championship and prizes at the end of the series.

Broad River Adventure Park consist of 1900 acres of trail riding, 5 motocross tracks that range from pee wee to adult. Wash rack and outside showers are available or if you prefer you can take a dip in the river. Camp, RV or rent a cabin for a weekend of racing, trail riding and family fun.
