

**Lavonia: RJ Notches Number 62**

Lavonia, Georgia (9-18-10) The Southern All Stars Dirt Racing Series' winningest driver proved once again the 'Chattanooga Flash' is still alive and kickin' up the dirt around the southeast as he captured his third series victory of the season and sixty-second all-time by winning the 16th Annual Georgia State Championships at Lavonia Speedway in Lavonia, Georgia on Saturday night.

Johnson, starting from his outside front row starting spot along side upstart and current SAS Rookie of the Year point leader Scott Creel of Franklinton, Louisiana, was never seriously challenged en-route to the \$5,000 victory.

Current SAS and defending SAS Champion Randy Weaver of Crossville, Tennessee was engaged in a fierce battle for second place with Creel before grabbing second in the closing laps of the fifty-lap affair. Creel finished third, followed by local favorite Casey Roberts of nearby Toccoa, Georgia and hall of famer Jack Pennington of Winston, Georgia rounded out the top five.
