

Bubba Pollard: 2010 Super Late Model Champ!

Even though Pollard was much faster than Chase through the middle of the turns, never once, to my surprise, did he "rattle Elliott's cage". And Chase had just enough down the chutes to keep Bubba in check as he drove on to the checkered in this event honoring his grandfather.

Also on this night, the 2010 Outlaw Late Model Series Championship was awarded to David Murphy after the division's point leader, Jason Bates, was involved in a crash on lap one of the double-point 35-lap feature.

And race fans, I'm looking forward to Saturday night, October 9th ... again in double-point events, the Pro Late Models and the Trucks will be competing for their championship



titles along with the Mini-Stocks and Street Stocks! All four titles are up for grabs ... this will be an exciting night of racing! In addition, the Outlaw Late Models are scheduled for a non-points event.

Please come join us at Gresham as we watch our lady, Brittany Finley, the "Alabama Belle", attempt to secure her place in history by driving to the first GMP Truck Series title. Currently, she has a 75-point lead ... but it's a double point night ...

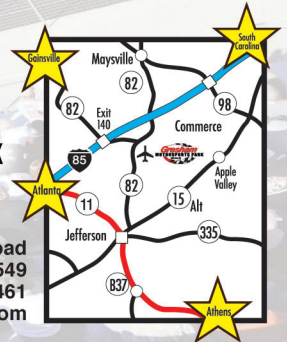
