Michael Page has been suspended for a full year from Iron-Man Series competition. The series announced the penalty on Wednesday, 12 January. The suspension begins January 12, 2022 and runs through January 12, 2023.

To add to Page's woes, who originally dominated the race was declared the winner at the DIRTcar Sunshine Nationals in Florida at the Volusia Speedway Park. Hours after the race was completed, series officials put out a memo notifying fans of the disqualification (DQ).

Per a DIRTcar release, "It was determined by DIRTcar and Crate Racin' USA officials

that Page's car had a valve spring installation height infraction, nullifying his victory. Upon a passing inspection of Bronson's engine, Kyle Bronson was awarded the \$10,000 check and declared the Feature winner."

"We won \$10,000, motor got torn down and was 100 percent right and everything passed. So, I'm more than happy with it. We won two races this week for \$20,000 and it's going to help us pay for Speedweeks a little bit," Bronson said.
